Nicholas Hart is a Clinical Research Consultant in Respiratory & Critical Care Medicine within Guy's & St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust and Kings College London Comprehensive Biomedical Research Centre. In addition to providing clinical support for Critical Care, he provides support to the Lane Fox Respiratory Unit, which is the regional weaning and non-invasive ventilation unit specialising in providing long-term support for patients with neuromuscular, skeletal deformities, chronic obstructive airways disease and obesity-related respiratory failure. He is a co-author of over 30 peer-reviewed original articles. His research is focused on advanced physiological monitoring, ventilation and rehabilitation with his current projects assessing and monitoring respiratory muscle activity in acutely breathless patients, investigating different ventilatory strategies for patients with obesity-related respiratory failure, neuromuscular disease and COPD, and rehabilitation for patients during weaning, following critical illness and post lung cancer resection.
