Paolo Navalesi works at the University Hospital Maggiore della Carità in Novara (Italy); he is head of the Intensive Care Unit of the Department of Anesthesia and Intensive Care and teaches at the School of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care of the Eastern Piedmont University "A. Avogadro".

Dr. Paolo Navalesi is Chairman of the Group "Non invasive ventilatory support" of the European Respiratory Society. He collaborates with the Italian Health Minister for the Continuous Medical Education in Pulmonary Medicine. He is author or co-author of several studies focused on mechanical ventilation and published in international journal, and has contributed to review articles and book chapters. He is independent referee for several international scientific journals.
